Dress Code

Crowsnest Consolidated High School aims to create and maintain a professional and friendly atmosphere in which teachers can teach and students can learn. The school climate shall foster a safe, secure, and caring learning environment which nurtures personal growth and promotes positive attitudes. We recognize that while each student's mode of dress and grooming may be an expression of personal style and individual preference, however a student's choices may affect the educational program for other students and the overall school climate.

Students and staff are expected to adhere to the following dress code guidelines:

1. Headwear is allowed in the classroom environment at the discretion of the staff member.
2. Inappropriate dress includes:
 - a. Clothing that glorifies or advertises drugs, alcohol, or sexual behavior.
 - b. Clothing that contains violent, discriminatory, vulgar or obscene words, pictures or symbols.
 - c. Clothing that exposes underwear or is revealing in nature.
 - d. Clothing that exposes cleavage, midriff or back.
 - e. Shorts, skirts, skorts or dresses measuring higher than a hand-length above the knee.
